
Did You Know... New Comment Field!

When you go to post your interim grades in Genesis, you will notice a new comment field – Failure Comment. This field will be used to track students that are in danger of failing a specific course. You will have three options within the comment field:

- Student in danger of failing due to excessive absences
- Student in danger of failing due to poor grades
- Student in danger of failing due to excessive absences and poor grades

If you have a student that is in danger of failing your class, please select one of these comments. These comments will not appear on the Progress Report or on the Report Card. However, the Office personnel will be able to run reports to view which students are in danger of failing a course.

To use these comments, when posting your Progress Report grades, select an option from the Failure Comment field and continue to post your grades as normal. If the student is NOT in danger of failing, leave this option blank.
