** Testing time is the maximum amount of time allotted for students to complete the assessment. Most students finish well in advance of the allotted time.

*** The testing window is the period in which districts can administer the assessment; it is not the actual number of days it takes a student to test. Schools can choose which days within the testing window that it wants to assess students. Please inquire with your school administrator about the exact testing dates of the assessment.
